

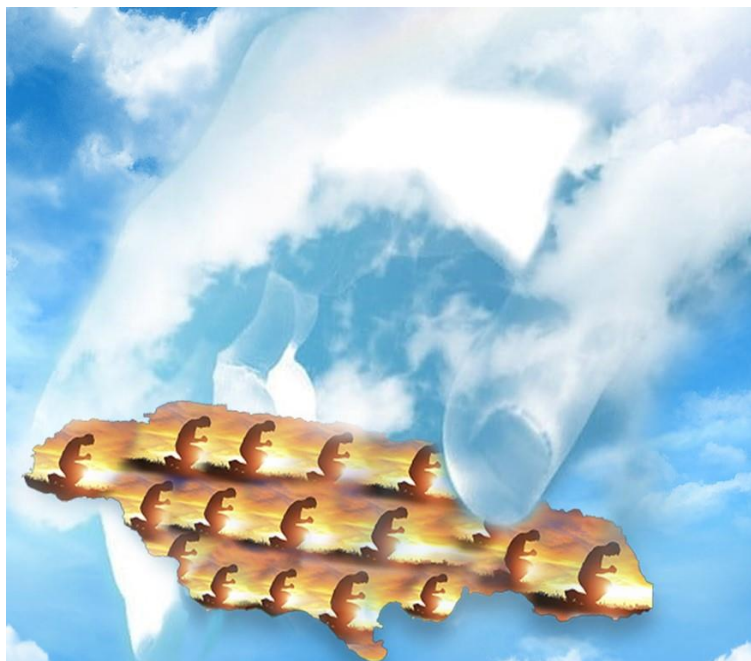

There are some who will be content to repeat the national anthem verbatim and to sing it as some circumstances call for, there are others who will want to pray it. Not only will they pray it but will break it down as Moses did in Deuteronomy 28 and command it upon the nation of Jamaica. While we continue to look at the other tenets of the national prayer, or should I say, the anthem of our prayers, we summarize this chapter by taking the prayers in detail from the first prayer in the national anthem. This is particular for the prayer warriors, watchers over this nation to declare before the throne of God. It is for

those who will travail for this nation to detail this national prayer and command it into reality, in all its facets and manifested potential.

Every line in the prayer below is an individual prayer to pray from this one prayer, the first prayer in the Jamaican national anthem of prayers, eternal Father bless our land.

Bank accounts will be the only thing to inflate
Bless us when we go out and come again
When we travel and when we land
When we execute and when we plan
Bless the work of our hands
Grant us the spirit of excellence and distinction
The grace for power and distinguishing wisdom
Creativity and innovation
That's what it means to be Jamaican
There will be no shortage of ground produce
International demand for all we do
We speak riches and abundance
We reject barrenness of womb or land
Plenty of goods, plenty of children
Plenty of wealth, plenty of savings
No more borrowing instead we lend
No more IMF to dictate our trends
Never the tail only the head
Never beneath, leaders instead
And the greatest blessings of them all
As we pray to You, O God

GUARD US WITH YOUR MIGHTY HAND

The second prayer of the national anthem is: *Eternal Father, guard us with Thy mighty hand.*

This prayer is effectively asking God to be a little sanctuary for us in this big, hostile and wicked world. The reference for this is Ezekiel 11:16. Here God, referring to Israel, said that although He has scattered them, He will be a little sanctuary for them in the nations they are carried to. In other words, even in hostile, uncertain and foreign environments, God is able to guard with His mighty hand.

Once again, we summarize this chapter with prayers. For those who are not intentional about praying, repeating the national anthem with understanding is enough. For those who are determined to see every prayer in Jamaica's national anthem in all their facets become the manifest reality of this nation and will sacrifice in prayer to usher it in, below are a number of prayers derived from and consistent with this second prayer for you to pray.

- Let brimstone, fire and a burning wind be the portion of those who secretly shoot at any Jamaican
- We send fire to any murderous spirit rampaging in this country
- We release the spirit of the avenger of blood to every murderer in this nation falsely claiming impunity
- We arrest the spirit of bloodshed, hatred, revenge and war in this nation.
- And release peace
- Peace be within your shores Jamaica
- Peace to everyone who thinks peaceably about you
- Withdraw the peace of every one who is planning evil
- Peace be to your children Jamaica
- Angels defend your shores
- Peace to every household and peace to every heart
- Guard us Eternal Father, with Your mighty hand

Preservation from animosity
Protection from nature's velocity

- I am a Jamaican
- We are guarded by the mighty hand of God
- This means, the hand of God protects me
- No evil shall befall me
- The Lord is a wall around me
- The angels of the Lord surround me
- As the mountains surround Jerusalem
- They encamp all around me
- Nothing shall make me afraid
- No plague shall come near my dwelling place

- Under the shadow of His wings, I am secure and safe
- No demonic work can harm me in any way
- Witchcraft, voodoo, or obeah has no power over me
- I am free from every evil assignment and projection
- Evil powers have no authority in my nation nor in my environment
- I have angelic immunity from bloodshed
- My life is precious to the Lord
- I will not die prematurely
- I live in a protected nation,
- Heavily and heavenly defended territory
- The Lord is my shield and my defense
- I refuse guard rings and demonic help
- Why should I forsake my tower of strength?

KEEP US FREE FROM EVIL POWERS

The third prayer in the Jamaican national anthem is: Eternal Father, keep us free from evil powers. carrying the inditements.

It is not acceptable to perpetrate or accommodate
The work of wickedness or witchcraft in any form
In a nation such as this, no not in a nation such as
this

There is a prayer released, actively searching
The command of angels actively working
Against every power of evil, wherever lurking
To rid us from them totally and to prevent its
resurgence

For in a nation such as this
The marine kingdom has no power
The powers of the air are arrested
The powers in the earth totally restricted

Those under the earth cannot manifest here
In a nation such as this
Paraded by warring angels
Empowered by the call of our national anthem
This prayer has become a trap
For all who are involved any at all
In engaging evil powers
Witchcraft, secret societies or voodoo workers
Or corrupt use of delegated powers
For scarce benefits and to oppress others
By their own prayers they will be condemned
Father, keep us free from all of them.



PRAYERS

We now break this prayer into specific prayers for the prayer warriors.

- Eternal Father, in accordance with the collective prayer of every citizen of this nation to keep us free from evil powers, let every time this prayer is repeated before You since independence, come before You now as You answer speedily and decisively:

- No witch is allowed to fly here; the heavens are programed with angelic fire, the silver cords are cut now
- Every link to and from global networks of evil and wickedness into this nation is totally destroyed, dismantled and removed. They cannot penetrate our angelic guard. Let fire feedback from this nation to arrest and uproot these demonic networks.
- Let the fire of the Lord burn up every symbol of wickedness and association with evil powers from our household and citizens; let the guard rings, the oils and other symbols catch fire now.
- Let every corrupt official who is perverting their delegated powers for personal interest be uprooted by the hook of the living God and cast out as garbage.
- Let the hearts of the people of this nation be turned away from evil to good
- Let the evil intent of global powers be disappointed; turn their sights from this nation
- Let every association and covenant with foreign nations that carries evil intent be nullified

- Let the finger of God uproot and scatter every foundations' wickedness in this nation
- Generational curses have no power to persist in this nation against individuals or families
- Cultural wickedness is arrested and removed
- Father, we thank You for Your patrol of thirty million angels, ten for each citizen, to keep us free from evil powers
- I soak this nation in the blood of Jesus Christ; let evil powers be repelled perpetually.
- Evil activities and organizations crumble now by the fire on this nation
- Every person or institution promoting anything that is contrary to the word of God attract the fire of God now
- Let every visitor to this nation receive freedom from demonic bondages, oppression, depression, generational curses, financial hardships and healing from sicknesses because they have come to this place of solution. What followed them has no accommodation here.
- We set up this prayer to stand in the gates of this nation, the airports, sea ports and internet ports and to revoke every permit for any evil spirit or influence to enter our shores.
- Turn the hearts of our leaders to righteousness and truth
- Turn the hearts of our people to righteousness and truth
- By the strength of our prayer as a nation that binds the hearts of every Jamaican, that You keep us free from evil powers Eternal Father, all these are settled without compromise or exclusion. Judge my heart also since I am not excluded. Judge my family and uproot evil. Enter into

my lineage and uproot every evil that may have existed. Forgive my forefathers Lord. You have full authority, keep my community free from evil powers. Keep my school free from evil powers. Keep my business free from evil powers. Keep my children and my generation free from evil powers. Let this prayer be the reality in my life.

- Let the fire of the Lord that burnt in the heart of Josiah burn in the heart of every believer to engage these prayers in fervent and effectual intercession.

- I am a Jamaican
- I clothe myself in the protective cover of this prayer; keep us free from evil powers

- My heart is perfect towards God; I refuse to take or give a bribe to pervert justice
- I will demonstrate integrity in my home
- I am protected by the angels of the living God
- I refuse to invite or engage evil powers in my home
- Corrupt officials in local or central government of this nation are uprooted now
- I shall dwell in safety
- My community is free from evil powers

- Territorial spirits are permanently arrested in my environment
- The marine kingdom is silenced over this nation
- Generational curses have no power over me and my household
- Satanic bondages are permanently broken over my life
- Evil powers are broken over my children
- My deliverance is permanent

BE OUR LIGHT

The fourth prayer of the Jamaican national anthem, 'Eternal Father, be our light through countless hours,' is weighty beyond imagination.

The request for light assumes the existence of darkness.

BE OUR LIGHT

The prayer in Jamaica's national anthem is not just asking God to send us light, but to 'BE' our light. This is so powerful for it proposes that God would be with and in this nation constantly; that God would not just shine 'on' this nation but shine 'from' this nation. That as God is the physical light in heaven, His presence will be the light that dispels, muzzles and drives away every power of darkness targeting Jamaica. Revelation 22:5, states that the city of God has no sun for God is

the light and in chapter 21:23 it states there is neither sun or moon, God the Father and the Lamb are the light. Could it be that this connotes an intention of consecration of this nation to God? Certainly, God cannot be anywhere that is not consecrated. Food for thought!

By asking God to be our light we stepped off the roof and have fallen into the natural manifestation of everything the light of God assumes and carries.

The fifth prayer in the Jamaica national anthem, is: Great Defender, grant our leaders true wisdom from above.

The physical resources of the nation were not much but its creative resources from the export of its wisdom brought immeasurable wealth and respect for Israel in his day. It is still the talk on the tongues today. As we pray this prayer for Jamaica with intent, we can anticipate to see her sons and daughters arising with distinction among the nations of the earth bringing great wealth and prominence to this nation. True wisdom is a product with export value.



PRAYERS

- Distinguishing wisdom, be the portion of every Jamaican in Jesus name.
- Let the riches, honor and glory that come from true wisdom, clothe this nation now
- Wisdom to make good decisions with pure motives rest in the hearts of our leaders at all levels
- Power to think beyond the moment to the long-term impact propel our leaders to good decisions
- I send fire to demonic wisdom in this nation that is self-seeking, arrogant and wicked. It shall not stand.
- Let the wisdom that is pure and peaceable be put on show by all our leaders
- We cry O Lord for true wisdom from above, gentle wisdom, merciful wisdom, wisdom that is peaceable, full of integrity and good works.
- Let the fear of the Lord rest in the bosom of our leaders like burning fire
- Every act and every decision taken in this nation will be done from the oracles of heaven, with precision and true wisdom.
- We release the grace for true wisdom into the hearts of our future leaders; the children and youths of today.
- I speak right motives to every decision taken in every place or position of leadership.
- Spirt of the living God, have the final say in every decision at all levels in this nation; You are wisdom.

- Wisdom to enter into good partnerships and to avoid devious ones settle the hearts of our national leaders

LET JUSTICE BE OURS FOREVER

The sixth prayer in the Jamaica national anthem is a cry for justice. Eternal Father, let justice be ours forever.

This prayer, Eternal Father, let justice be ours forever, is asking God to uproot injustice in all its forms, shapes and manifestation from our nation forever. This means that:

Our justice system will be fast and accurate. Delayed justice is in many cases injustice.

Crime will not go unpunished but our crime-fighting machinery will be effective. Murderers and rapists will not find any place, personality or person to hide behind from justice. Bloodshed will not be

unanswered. The cry of the land will attract heaven's response as with Abel's blood, and heaven will arrest every murderer walking free.

There will be equal opportunities for the poor, orphans, needy and marginalized.

Corruption and bribery in all manifestations will be booted from our nation. Bribery will be exposed and expelled at all levels of government and civil society and the perpetrators brought to criminal responsibility.

The innocent in prison will be released and recompensed.

There will be justice for everyone who is unjustly treated.

There will be heaven's vindication for the maligned, misrepresented and falsely accused.

The cry of our children facing abuse will be answered speedily.

Inequalities will be driven out of our society.

The wealth of the nation will benefit all its citizens and not just an elite few.

And every other form of administration of justice.



PRAYER

- Eternal Father, You are a just God; establish Your character in our judicial system.
- By the power in the blood of Jesus, I clothe our judicial system with speed and accuracy in judgment and that every case will be decided justly.
- Spirit of the Holy Ghost, rain confusion upon everyone using deception to distort the hand of justice in this nation.
- I spread the net of the Lord upon every person in this nation flagrantly abusing justice.
- Let the fire of the living God uproot corruption in this nation.
- Let the angels of the living God enter into every public office in this nation and arrest the spirit of bribery.
- I remove the impunity enjoyed by criminals and corrupt officials in this nation. Let the hook of the living God flush them out for justice.
- I assign the finger of God against every system, organization or secret movement or society promoting or supporting injustice in this nation.

- By the Holy Ghost and fire, I release justice to the abused in this nation.
- I release justice to the marginalized.
- I release equal opportunities to every citizen, in Jesus' name.
- I release justice to this nation for every hardship caused by the abuse of office.
- Criminals cannot hide in our communities; let the whirlwind of the Lord uproot them.
- Criminals cannot hide in our homes, we set them on fire, in Jesus' name.
- Criminals cannot hide behind smiles and pleasant personalities; let the fire of the Lord dismantle their cover.
- Criminals cannot hide behind wealth or public office in this nation, let evil angels afflict them.
- I reject every spirit of injustice and partiality in this nation.
- I call forth the resolve in the spirit of every Jamaican to be faithful to their vow before God to stand up for justice.
- I stir up a burning hatred in the spirit of every Jamaican towards evil and injustice. Let it be an abomination to us.

- Criminals in this nation will receive their just reward
- I will work hard to attain all my goals
- I shall not be cheated or robbed by wickedness
- I am a just person living in a just nation; this is my comfort and confidence as a citizen of Jamaica.



TRUTH BE OURS FOREVER

The seventh prayer is a prayer for truth. Eternal Father let truth be ours forever.

Some will say that this prayer is intricately linked with the cry for justice and cannot be separated. This is correct in parts. You cannot have justice without truth and you cannot have truth without justice. Yet justice and truth are two very independent requests and therefore you cannot understand the power of this mix unless you examine them separately.

Can you imagine:

A nation where no one lies to you

Lawyers and politicians speak the truth

Will not subvert themselves for power

Cause it what it will; any time any hour

Where truth becomes a product

All will buy and none will sell

Child to parents, husbands to wives
Wives to husbands as well
Where the tax returns reflect
All the income that is earned
And the price of the goods imported
Are not modified to keep it down
Where the young man courting the lady
Will not marry somebody else
Where the lips of those in trouble
Will not lie their way to hell
You are a true Jamaican
If you constantly speak the truth

- I will court truth at all times and I will take truth to court
- I will not lie for advantage or favor
- I embrace the word of truth and the Spirit of truth
- I see everything through the law of truth
- I will never manipulate

- I hate witchcraft
- I love the truth
- I will buy the truth and I refuse to sell it.



JAMAICA LAND WE LOVE

It is obvious from the prayers we have examined so far that the national anthem is not just casual repetition but is asking God for significant and specific involvement in every area of the life of this nation. What could inspire a nation to invite God in such a sweeping way? It is very obvious in the refrain of this anthem. Jamaica has wholeheartedly invited God to be a part of the nation's life, or rather, to be the life of this nation because we love this nation. This national prayer um... anthem, that calls for commitment, alignment, self-accountability, moves beyond selfishness, personal passion or religion to one thing, the best interest of the nation Jamaica. It means every Jamaican may have to hold themselves

accountable and may even get caught and punished when God moves to answer our prayer, but patriotism means they submit. They will say: even though I may die on the battle field, the nation comes first; I fight and sing, Jamaica, Jamaica, Jamaica land we love. The cry to God, Eternal Father, may be self-implicating but the love of this nation demands the best for her: the best defense, the best protection, the best leadership, the best citizens, the best use of our resources. There is no nation, people or wealth source on earth who has the ability, agility, willingness and our interest, as God the Eternal Father. Indeed, after praying all these prayers above and understanding the extent of what we are praying, we pause to regurgitate the reason that we are so committed and why we can have nothing else or do it any other way. It is captured in this refrain: Jamaica, Jamaica, Jamaica land we love.

- Indeed, Jamaica land we love; I agree and will cooperate with anything that makes you the best you can be.



INTERPERSONAL PRAYERS

The second set of prayers in the national anthem is mainly interpersonal. Jesus, in response to the question of which is the greatest commandment responded that nothing beats loving God with everything, heart, strength, mind; but there was one just after, loving our neighbors as ourselves. The cross is made of horizontal and vertical wood. It symbolized the vertical and horizontal relationships embodied in the sacrifice. We reach up to God and draw on His pure love-filled energy to reach across to man.

It is no wonder that God who inspired this anthem by stirring the heart of the forefathers of this nation to write and to embrace it, placed priority on the horizontal immediately after full emphasis on the vertical in the first stanza.



TEACH US TRUE RESPECT FOR ALL

The eighth prayer in the Jamaican national anthem is: Eternal Father, teach us true respect for all.

Not what they deserve but what they are deserving
Politeness, care and tender-hearted giving
To serve each other every day
Affirming them till they attain
For love's the language of our hearts
With gratitude and appreciation of
Everyone from the very start
Opportunities held opportunities sought
(To appreciate, elevate and to applaud)
How you speak to and about them
You address you the way you address them
Jamaica where 'nuff respect' is the social norm
Not just a slang or an idle talk
No partiality or preference or thought of harm
That is why, Eternal Father, we continually ask
Teach us true respect for all.



PRAYER

- Eternal Father. teach us true respect for all
- Let respect be not just empty words we say to each other, but demonstrated in the way we treat each other
- I speak respect as a core principle of the youths in this nation.
- We reject the western culture of disrespect of elderly and positions of honor, especially by our youths.
- Teach us to honor the elderly
- Let each Jamaican be respectful
- Turn the hearts of the fathers to the children and the children to the fathers in this nation
- I speak gentleness, patience, politeness to every Jamaican in the way we communicate with each other
- I commit every Jamaican to honor
- By the finger of God, I uproot the culture of taking offence, or dissing, from our nation
- Let our people refuse to take offence or execute vengeance on the basis of offence.
- I crush the spirit of retaliation
- Let life flow from the way we treat each other
- I declare that this society is a respectful society
- Forgive us heavenly Father for the offences we have created and the unforgiveness we have held in this nation.
- Let the fire of the living God repel public spats or dishonor to and from public officials
- Power to affirm fall into the spirits of the citizens of this nation
- Help us to make our fellow-Jamaicans feel loved and appreciated

- Grace to cover the weaknesses of others be ours today.
- Power to respect the property and rights of others, sweep the hearts of every Jamaican today.

- I am polite
- I am patient with everyone
- I am gentle
- I will listen to what others have to say
- I refuse to hold on to an offence
- I forgive my fellow Jamaican in advance

The ninth prayer in Jamaica's national anthem is: Eternal Father, stir response to duty's call (to the call of duty).

Duty to our country beckons,
The brave and strong respond;
To engage military service and
to give ourselves to pick up arms
Sometimes we think this line of prayer
Is fulfilled in this one way
And ignore that duty calls us
into combat every day
With due regard to the public service
and those who daily risk their lives
To police where violence threatens
and those facing the flames of fire
To health workers and to our teachers;
and to our government at large
But understand to every person,
there is combat, there's a call
Duty calls you into conflict

when you do your best each day
At every task that you engage in,
however, simple it appears
When you reach for your attainments,
and be the best that you can be
The country rises and is strengthened
if every person should achieve.

Duty calls every citizen of this nation to be good community citizens and to contribute to its development, safety, and cleanliness. Duty calls fathers to be present and active in the lives of their children. Duty calls every citizen to assist the poor and needy, and to remember orphans and those on the street. Duty calls the offended to make peace so our nation may be in peace. Duty calls the children to their chores; to those responsible, to ensure dishes are washed and the house and yard

are clean. Duty calls students to read, study and excel. Duty calls our athletes and international representatives to be their best. Duty calls us all never to harbor a criminal in whatever form, white collar or no collar at all, just brazen. Duty calls us to be courteous to each other and to foreigners. Duty calls us to apply the work necessary to ensure our creative ideas and books are completed. It is a never quit until you win attitude.

- Let the spirit of entitlement find no rest on our shores; we replace it with the passion for work and participation.
- Let every Jamaican be empowered with the power to organize, structure and attend to details.
- Let the call to action in our communities, or nation be met with eagerness.
- Let there be a response to the cry of the poor and underprivileged.
- Let the call to attend to the souls of men be met with urgency; stir response in the hearts of believers in this nation.
- By the power in the blood of Jesus I empower Jamaicans to:

- Engage every task with energy and precision even when they are not comfortable with it.
- To recognize the call of duty in every small task they undertake, even when no one is watching and to apply energy and enthusiasm to it.

THE WEAK TO CHERISH

The tenth prayer in the Jamaican national prayer/ anthem, is: Eternal Father, strengthen us the weak to cherish.

This prayer is asking God to empower us to cherish the weak. The weak is a general classification for everyone in need of help. It includes the widows, the poor, the fatherless, the disabled, the distressed, the prisoners, the mentally disabled, the homeless, the addicts and every other category that we may assist to be the best version of themselves. It implies a very loving, sharing and caring society.

We cry eternal Father, strengthen us the weak to cherish. Give all Jamaicans the explosive compulsion to go overboard to

make the weak feel strong and at home in this island nation.

If this is the case it is supported and corroborated by our national pledge. It is a pledge to use the wisdom and courage of our minds and all the strength we have in our bodies to serve each other.

- Eternal Father, soften my heart towards fellow Jamaicans and empower me to intervene on their behalf.
- I speak love and empathy into the hearts of every Jamaican; let the pleasure of service be ours.
- I drive selfishness from the hearts of our people and replace it with selflessness; I drive stinginess from the hearts of our people and replace it with extravagant giving.
- Holy Spirit, give us an eye to see the needs of others above and apart from our own needs, and the heart to respond.
- Give us the right attitude towards service; let us do so with eagerness, enthusiasm, and to go overboard to make our fellow Jamaicans feel at home in our service on this island we share.
- Thank You heavenly Father for allowing needs, so we have an opportunity to express Your heart here. Help us to embrace these opportunities tightly.

- Thank You heavenly Father for all Your promises linked to intervention in the needs of others; we claim all of these promises. You will bless us, expand us and lift us up.
- Release upon every person born in this nation a generous spirit from birth; let the spirit of Jamaicans and Jamaica be interwoven with generosity.
- Empower us financially to help others and to meet needs.
- Empower us with love and empathy so we cannot resist the opportunities to intervene.
- Teach us to love each other as we love ourselves; give us the resolve to think about others and to put them first.
- Strengthen us in spirit, heavenly Father, so we may cherish those who are weak.

The eleventh prayer in Jamaica's national anthem is: "Eternal Father, grant us vision so we do not perish" (come to ruin). This is a direct response to Proverbs 29:18 which states that where there is no vision the people perish.

- I release the grace for foresight and effective planning upon every leader in this nation
- Power to sacrifice now to dictate a deliberate future, rest in the bosom of every Jamaican.

- I release the support of the relevant people for every good vision. Let both the visionaries and those impacted by it have one heart.

- I come against every spirit of resistance that will seek to frustrate good visions.
- Willingness to suffer pain to secure gain be ours today.
- I release to every child and youth of this nation a vision for their life and future
- I release to this nation the tenacity and resolve necessary to see visions become reality

- Father, give to every Jamaican an understanding heart to adequately decipher knowledge and wisdom to apply it.

- Most high God, let our search for knowledge be mixed with understanding to create a thirst for knowledge.
- Folly that pushes people to learn by negative experience what has already been tested, written and recorded be driven from the hearts of our citizens.
- I declare that citizens of this nation will not waste time and resources rediscovering what is already available
- Books shall be the friend of every Jamaican
- Our children shall read their textbooks and excel on every examination
- Spirit of innovation be stirred in the heart of every Jamaican; breakthrough discovery be ours today.
- I release upon every Jamaican a holy dissatisfaction with doing without knowing or understanding; we shall be empowered with knowledge.
